- Tibet close for tourist in the month of march and open first week of April. Earliest we can enter Tibet by second week of April 2018
- Tibet visa is not granting for passport holder those travel in Muslim countries after 2015
- Chinese authority in Tibet and as well as Kathmandu can anytime reject the visa approval, permit and visa in last moment if they suspect the involvement of fee Tibet or qualm
- Do not take any book containing Dalai Lama's picture, free Tibet stickers can Tibetan flag
- Filming is not allowing in this region due to political reason. However, we can take small handy cam and film in river while raft
The given cost is valid for foreign tourist group only. For Indian pax need minimum of 5 Indian and visa is issue in Chinese Embassy Delhi. Cost may differ since Indian group is operate by China Indian Pilgrimage Service Center (CIPSC)

- 10% Two weeks prior to departure date
- 20% One-week prior to departure date
- 30% 3 days prior to departure date
- No refund will be applied for cancellation when arrived in Kathmandu and cancel the trip
